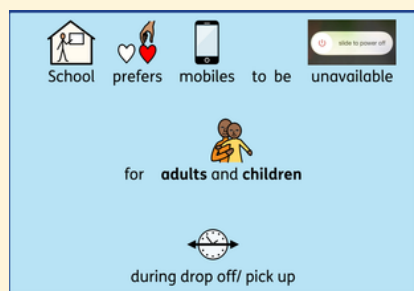

Sarah Jackson, new head teacher for September will be visiting both sites over the coming months to familiarise herself with pupils, staff and parents. She is unable to attend parent consultation dates due to other commitments in her current school.

We will reach our school capacity in Sept with all 36 classes being in use. Legrave site is undergoing the final phase of construction and last disruption to car parking facilities, thank goodness. Thank you to the parents who have lived with it for the past 3 years...the end is in sight.



Over the past year there has been an increase of parental mobile use when collecting/ dropping off children. Children need their parents full attention, so please do not be offended if you are asked to terminate your phone call.

Whilst we are aware screens can be a regulator and comfort to many, studies also show high frequency use can also cause longer term disconnect and dysregulation. Signs will be appearing on site to encourage a reduction in use while on site.

We are exploring the possibility of converting LZW Legrave front lawn and wooded area into a forest school, this is in the early stages and will start at the earliest in September. Both sites will be able to access this differentiated outdoor learning area. 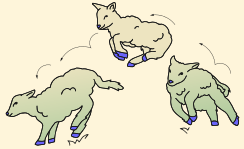
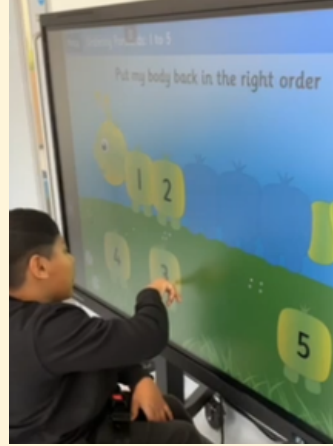
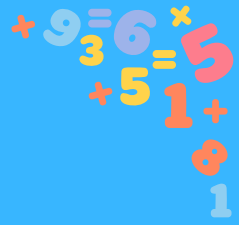

PRACTICALITIES FOR PARENTS:

School day is 9.00 - 3.00pm

Parents collect from 3.00pm to allow 10mins for transition. Children arriving late go to reception, unless otherwise directed. Listen to staff wearing hi-vis, they are there to promote safety for all.

Pupils should attend punctually and inline with their fulltime entitlement.

Holidays during term time are not authorised. Attendance policy states penalty notices can be issued.

Pupil attendance is monitored via Studybugs, please download the app. If your child is absent or late, please communicate via the app before 9.00am, otherwise it could be recorded as unauthorised absence and a school dinner may not be available.



Stopsley: EYFS, Rose, Iris, Daffodil, Freesia, Lily, Bluebell and Tulip access direct to classrooms. All others to side entrance.

Leagrave: Mulberry, Ash, Pine, Acer & Cedar to North entrance, all others to South entrance (EYFS carry on through to their playground entrance).

Parking: There are more parents than parking spaces. Be considerate when parking, both sites have their challenges with spaces.

- All drivers to park in designated bays (including taxi's)
- Do not block others in, unless by mutual agreement
- Drivers park at own risk
- At busy times ensure you return to car asap, avoid longer conversations with staff
- Be mindful of moving traffic, speed limit is 5mph
- Listen to staff wearing hi-vis, we are trying to help everyone as best we can



PRACTICALITIES FOR PARENTS:

Volunteers are welcome. We often need extra support especially for reading and swimming. Contact the office if you are interested in giving some time to school.



Parents can supply healthy snacks and drink. School does not purchase snacks or juice. Under 5s qualify for free milk and 4-6 year olds access the government free fruit & vegetables scheme. Parents are required to supply wipes and pads for their child.



School uniform is encouraged as it helps pupils with routine and belonging. Uniforms can be ordered from Prestige Work Wear and Design. Label clothing, bags and resources from home.

Classes communicate via [Seesaw](#). For classroom/ pupil information and occasional photos/ videos to be shared securely. Urgent / emergency messages, reporting absence or requests for leave should continue to go through the school office. Teachers communicate approximately 3 times per week.



A number of different contractors are used by Luton Transport (PTU). Enquiries and concerns should be made directly with the contractor, other enquiries and safeguarding concerns should be reported to PTU. Ensure you have correct contact details to follow up with your child's transport needs & concerns.



School does not have jurisdiction over transport decisions.

Applications for travel assistance are required when moving house & changing schools etc.

SPECIAL SCHOOL NURSING TEAM



The onsite special needs nursing team provides clinical care to children and young people with complex physical health needs or disabilities. When they are off site, a phone service is available and emergency individual plans are activated.

Roles & Responsibilities:

Advice and Support: A wide range of advice including diet, sleep, continence and they are willing to discuss a child's medical needs with parents and to signpost/ guide where appropriate.

Growth monitoring: We measure children's height and weight in line with national guidelines.

Health Assessments: For each child in order to support in school, with referrals to other services etc. Complete and return this form ASAP and inform the nursing team of any changes to your child's health, medication etc.

Referrals: We can support families by referring to other services – i.e. Dietician, Continence Service, CAMHs etc.

Safeguarding: We are committed to safeguarding and liaise with local healthcare, social care and education services.

Specific Care Plans: e.g. epilepsy, wheeze, and diabetes. Parents to confirm and return these ASAP when they are sent home.

Classroom staff training for the following as per pupil need:

Anaphylaxis awareness.

Asthma awareness

Diabetes

Enteral Feeding and Enteral Medication Administration

Epilepsy Training

Oral Medication Administration

Suction Training

VNS training

The Nursing Team do not attend first aid incidents as these are managed by trained first aiders within the school.

The Nursing Team are not directly involved in any decision making when a child is unwell and needs to go home or if they can return to school for example ringworm/ vomiting and diarrhoea, school policies are followed in these instances.
